the sum of five cents upon a certain
game of Chance, then and there played
at and by means of a certain gambling
device, commonly called cards
adapted, devised and designed for the
purpose of playing games of chance
for money and property, contrary to
the form of the Statute in such
case made and provided, and against
the peace and dignity of the State
