

An improper memorandum of Claims reported to me & allowed after the paymaster had left the Service, not including Claims reported to the Auditor, I only state name & amount & when reported to Auditor it would require months to set out at length the reports and depositions affidavits & to send my reports to the Auditor for in nearly all the cases I had to make a separate report to the Auditor except in the Weatherly War Cases they did not give me so much trouble & you will observe that it required as much time in many cases to allow a small claim as it did a large one - the dates to the right of the ~~Name~~ Name shows when the claim was allowed ~~consequent~~ & the days engaged
