I am this moment in receipt of your favour of the 23<sup>rd</sup> ultimo & mailed on the 26<sup>th</sup> and also in receipt of the enclosed letter from my half brother who left here this morning.

I hope that my brother has not been misinformed the Town that he dates his letter at is immediately opposite Nauvoo. Since writing the above another respectable man has arrived at my house with the ~~word~~ same report that my brother sends me - he obtained his information from one of the leaders of the Church. In fact he told me that he had seen a letter from Do, stating that there would be no chance for him longer to escape, that the officers were then in Nauvoo &

In this same package I send you another letter that I had written before I was in receipt of either yours or my brother's letters. It is a fact that Smith ordered the Mormons back to Nauvoo that had started - The person of whom they were purchasing told me not 10 minutes since.
