N. B.—Every item of information should be carefully supplied. AGE should be stated EXACTLY. PHYSICIANS CAUSE OF DEATH in plain terms, so that it may be properly classified. Exact statement of OCCUPATION is very important.

The first part of the report deals with the general situation in the country. It is noted that the economy is still in a state of depression, and that the government is struggling to maintain its financial stability. The report also mentions the need for further reforms in the financial system.
