



Does the text box contain information on the content and context of the image (photographer, description, date, the institution where the image came from)?

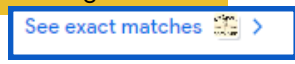
Download the image to your computer, using the downward facing arrow in the bottom right corner of the image.



Open a new browser tab and go to <https://images.google.com/>. Drag the image you have downloaded into the search bar, or upload the image from your computer using the Google Lens.



Look for the exact image, then click "See Exact Matches" underneath that image.



**SORT OF? IT DOESN'T HAVE EVERYTHING I NEED FOR MY CITATION**

Explore! Look for additional information about the image on websites and collection pages. Look for sources with reputable information like museums, journal articles, and newspaper articles.

Success! Use this information to build your citation.

**DID YOU FIND WHAT YOU NEED FOR YOUR CITATION?**

**NOT EVERYTHING!**

That's ok! If you can't find information for a field after a thorough search, don't include that field.

**Historic Trademarks - Ice Cream Sandwich**

Description: The 1904 Louisiana Purchase Exposition World's Fair in St. Louis marked the official debut of the ice cream cone. At the time, it was marketed as an ice cream sandwich or an ice cream cornucopia. [Cornucopia Waffle Oven Company of St. Louis](#) was the first to submit a trademark application for the ice cream cone. The ice cream cone was made Missouri's official state dessert in 2008.
