Open the image, journal, or other type of resource in the Internet Archive. Scroll below the record. Is there a text box with different types of information in it?

THERE'S A TEXT BOX, BUT NOT THAT MUCH INFORMATION IN IT

Scroll back up, and use information from the record itself. Periodicals and books typically include information like the date, publishing company, and Volume/Number within the first 10 pages. For other records, information may also be available at the back of the volume.

Does the text box contain information on the content and context of the record (publisher, description, date, the institution that contributed the record)?

Ideally the Internet Archive page should have information in the text box like the information to the left. Underlined is the information you can use to build a citation. You may need to look at the record itself for additional information not listed in the text box.
