Scope and Content

This is a ledger book that appears to have originally belonged to a general store in Claysville, Missouri. It is unknown if this is the Claysville in Clay County or the one in Boone County. The first part (pages 7-95) covers 1837-1838. The second part is written in pencil (unnumbered pages after 95, many pages skipped) and seems to be a personal accounting of household expenses. This latter portion covers 1879-1898.
