HISTORICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Senator Morris Westfall, born April 5th, 1939, attended the University of Missouri-Columbia (B.S., Agriculture). He married Sharon Douglas and had two children, Craig and Christi. Westfall served in the United States Marine Corps; he was discharged in 1965.

Westfall was first elected to the House in 1971 via a special election, filling out the term that had been held by his father Raymond Earl “Johnny” Westfall. He was then reelected five times,

serving House District 133 from 1973 to 1981, the last year resigning during his term to take up a federal appointment. He was elected to the Senate in 1994, serving two terms for District 28 from 1995-2003.

During his time as senator, Westfall served on the Appropriations and Education committees and served as chair for both the Civil and Criminal Jurisprudence and Transportation committees. Additionally, Westfall advocated for a variety of agricultural issues.

Outside of his legislative duties, Westfall was a livestock farmer, member of the Baptist Church, on the board of directors for Sheltered Workshop, and State Director of ASCS-USDA from 1981-1993.
