Historical and Biographical Notes

James Thomas Blair, Jr. was born on March 15, 1902 in the DeKalb County community of Maysville to James Thomas Blair, Sr. and Grace Emma Ray Blair. He attended public schools in Jefferson City and the Staunton Military Academy in Staunton, Virginia. Blair pursued higher education at Southwest Missouri State Teachers College (Missouri State University), the University of Missouri, and Cumberland University in Lebanon, Tennessee where he earned a law degree in 1924. He married Emilie Garnett Chorn of Kansas City on July 17, 1926 and the couple raised two children.

In 1925, Blair was elected city attorney for Jefferson City and in 1928 to the Missouri House of Representatives, serving two consecutive terms. Blair was elected president of the Missouri Bar Association in 1930 and returned to his law practice in Jefferson City in 1932. He served as chairman of the Cole County Democratic Committee for eight years and in 1936, served as a delegate to the Democratic National Convention.

During World War II, Blair served with the Army Air Corps in the European Theater and attained the rank of lieutenant colonel. Discharged in 1945, he returned to Missouri where in 1947 he was elected mayor of Jefferson City. He resigned from the office when he was elected lieutenant governor in 1948. He was elected as the 44th Governor of Missouri in 1956.

Blair, as Governor, established the Missouri Council on Education, supported legislation which created junior colleges, and championed the addition of a four-year medical school at the University of Missouri. He supported nursing home licensing legislation which tightened regulation on nursing home safety, provided for inspections, and imposed tougher penalties for those institutions which failed to comply. Blair also created the Missouri Commission on Human Rights and established the Missouri State Employees Retirement System.

After his term, he remained active with the Democratic Party. Blair supported the 1960 presidential candidacy of U.S. Senator Stuart Symington at the Democratic National Convention. Blair and his wife died of accidental carbon monoxide poisoning on July 12, 1962 in Jefferson City and are interred in Riverview Cemetery, Jefferson City.

See Domestic Extraditions Series for extradition requests made from Missouri by other states. Also includes affidavits, applications or petitions for requisition, depositions, expense claim forms, extradition forms, extradition hearing transcripts, lists of extraditions, memoranda, newspaper clippings, notes, telegrams, time cards, waiver of extradition rights, and warrants for arrest. Includes correspondence from the governors or secretaries of state for 45 states.

Miscellaneous correspondence includes replies from the governors of Arkansas, California, Colorado, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Maine, Massachusetts, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, and Wyoming. Miscellaneous correspondence is arranged in chronological order and thereunder alphabetical.

Select folders of this series were re-processed and re-numbered. Original box and folder numbers are indicated in parenthesis. Where joint extradition is asked for two or more fugitives, original filing designation and chronological order is retained.
