

**Missouri State Library  
Technology Ladder Grants  
Awarded April 2024**

Technology Ladder grants are open to qualified public libraries and provides funds for technology-related equipment and software. Specifically, this program is designed to help libraries move up the technology ladder to a higher level of service. These grant funds can be used to replace older equipment and software, to purchase new equipment or software or create or upgrade an existing website. It addresses LSTA Priority 2 and MOSL Goal 1.

Sixteen Technology Ladder Grant applications were received, requesting a total of \$367,486.93 and 16 grants were awarded \$245,270.00.00. The grant period is scheduled to begin on May 15, 2024.
