

## Missouri State Library Technology Mini Grants Awarded October 2024

Technology Mini-Grants provide funds to public libraries to assist with funding for technology and automation related equipment, other hardware, and software to improve the library’s network infrastructure. These grant funds can be used to replace older or purchase new equipment in order to provide improved library services.

Twenty-eight Technology Mini-Grant grant applications were received, requesting a total of \$345,828.67. Twenty-six grants were awarded a total of \$301,665.00. The grant period began November 15, 2024 and will end May 15, 2025.
