

School Nonfiction Collection Development Grants Awarded August 2014

This grant program provides funds to eligible public school districts to purchase collection development materials in support of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) learning programs.

This was an invitation-only, formula grant open to public school districts with school libraries in buildings that met the following criteria:

1. The school district must be fully or provisionally accredited by the Missouri State Board of Education
2. Elementary and secondary school libraries that receive funds through this grant must provide an accessible, centrally-housed and organized collection of resources.
3. The school district must have a line item in the district's budget for library materials.
4. The school library must be staffed by a person who either is, or is supervised by, a certified school librarian.
5. The free and reduced lunch percentage for the building is equal to or greater than 82%.

Buildings that received funds through a School Nonfiction Collection Development grant during school year 2013-2014 were ineligible to receive funds in this new award.
